Terms and Conditions

1. Application for garden landscaping is to be made in writing and the application must include a sketch of the garden and proposed positioning of plants.
2. Any plants must be Indigenous and specified on your sketch.
3. Proposed garden ornaments, gazebos, garden sheds, trellis work also need to be detailed and plotted on the sketch and for items higher than 50cm, a photograph or picture of the structure is also required.
4. Garden sheds are not allowed to stick out above your court yard wall.
5. Landscaping cannot commence until the application has been approved.
6. No Bougainvillea or Wisteria may be planted directly into the ground – they must be in pots.
7. Changes to gardens may in no way interfere with the main water lines, manholes, etc.
8. No flower beds are allowed next to any wall. Flower beds must at least be 400 mm away from any wall.
9. No trees may be planted near water lines.
